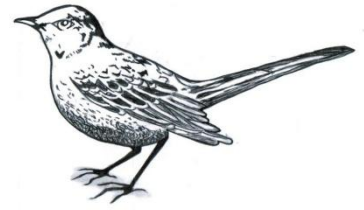

## New ART EXHIBITION at Mockingbird Lounge NOW ON!

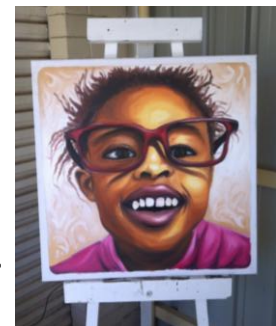
Come and have a look at the walls in Mockingbird Lounge! Every free space has been adorned with paintings by different local artists!
