After You'd Gone by Maggie O'Farrell

This is the book I have to thank for kick starting my enjoyment of reading and the fun discussions that follow at our Wednesday evening book club. This book has been my favourite so far. The complex world of 29 year old Alice Raikes is captured through the themes of family sagas and cross-cultural relationships in modern day love. The web of stories alternates between present and past as the main character Alice lies in a hospital bed in a coma. Questions are continuously raised throughout the novel as to her accidental stepping out in front of a vehicle - or was it! Alice's love for a man named John is at the heart of the story and I would never of thought that I was one for enjoying a love story but this relationship between Alice and John was wonderfully written. With its many challenges but modern approach to life as a couple, Alice and Johns' love story was what captivated me.
